

In June 1993, Joseph L. Mintzer of Wayne, Pennsylvania joined Coriell Institute for Medical Research (Coriell), Camden, New Jersey, as Vice President and Chief Operating Officer. He was promoted to Executive Vice President, Chief Operating Officer in March 2005. He is responsible for managing all of the administrative and financial operations of the Institute.
